


# ABOUT THE HUGH LANE GALLERY



## The Hugh Lane Gallery and how to get there

The Hugh Lane Gallery is located in Dublin's city centre on Parnell Square North, very close to O'Connell St.

You can get here by walking, bike, bus, car. The Luas and Dart are also close by. The gallery is completely wheelchair accessible with lifts to all floors. It is open from Tuesday to Sunday and admission is free.

## Visiting the Hugh Lane with your class

If you would like to visit with your class, you can book a guided tour by contacting our Education Department at least two weeks in advance of the proposed visit. Guided tours cost €30 up to a max of 30 students per group. You can also arrange a self-guided visit. Depending on availability, it can be possible to arrange a 1.5 hour combined tour & art workshops which costs €125. ## A short history of the Hugh Lane Gallery

Hugh Lane (1875-1915) was an art dealer and collector born in Cork. He was passionate about art and wanted to share this with the public. Together with his friends and with the support of his aunt Lady Augusta Gregory the Municipal Gallery of Modern Art was established in 1908 in Harcourt St, Dublin. In 1933, the gallery moved to Charlemont House in Parnell Square where it is today. Charlemont House was originally the townhouse of Lord Charlemont and was designed by the architect Sir William Chambers in 1765. A large extension was built recently bringing more space for the permanent collection and temporary exhibitions, a lively café along with a larger bookshop and a fantastic education resource space for fun art workshops.
