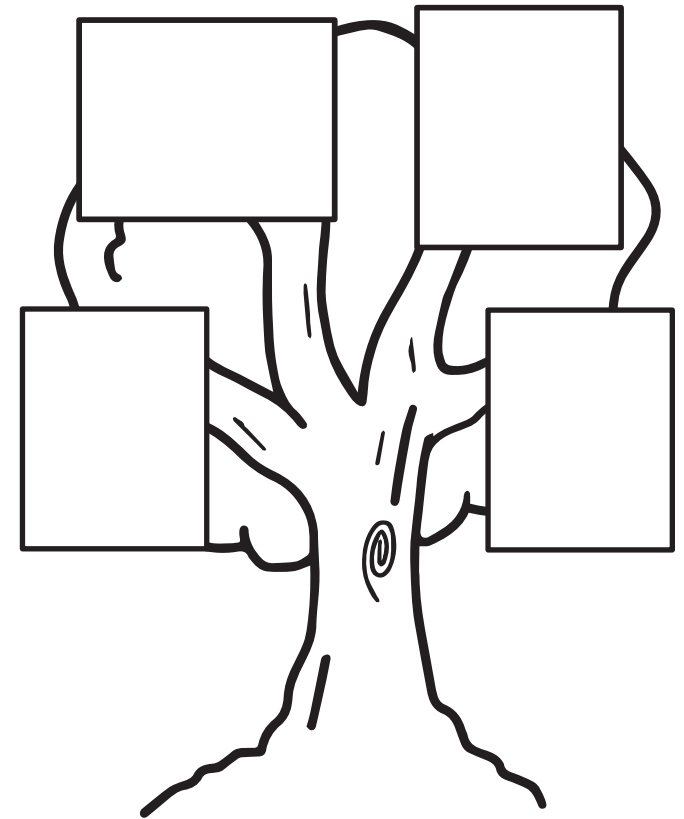
How many sounds can you hear on your way to and from school?

Can you find and draw four different types of leaves you can see on your way to school?

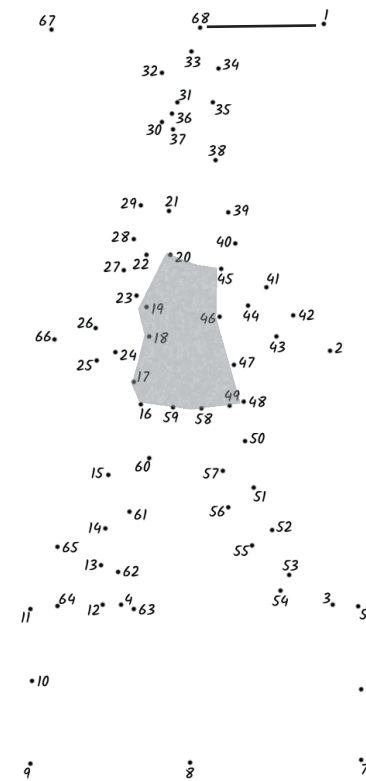


Create your own artwork here, it could be a cityscape or rubbing of a leaf or texture!

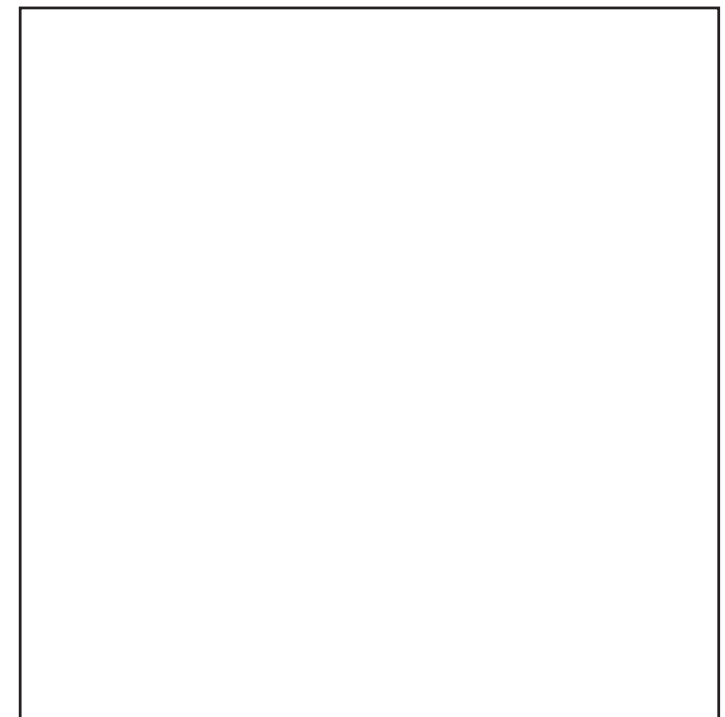


Turn the paper this way and create a portrait!
